M. Grazia Speranza graduated in 1980 and received her PhD in Applied Mathematics in 1983 at the University of Milan. She is full professor of Operations Research at the University of Brescia. She was Dean of the Faculty of Economics and Business from 2002 to 2008. She was Vice-President of IFORS (International Federation of Operations Research Societies) from 2008 to 2009 and is President of EURO (association of European Operational Research Societies) until the end of 2012.

The main scientific interests are: optimization models for transportation and logistics, vehicle routing problems, scheduling problems, mixed integer linear programming problems, exact and heuristic algorithms;

She is author of more than 100 papers that appeared in international journals such as Transportation Science, Management Science, Naval Research Logistics, Networks, Operations Research, Computers and Operations Research, INFORMS Journal on Computing, Journal of Heuristics, Transportation Research, Discrete Applied Mathematics, European Journal of Operational Research, Journal of Scheduling, Operations Research Letters. She has also published more than 30 papers in international volumes. She has been editor of volumes and special issues of journals. She serves at present as Associate Editor of Transportation Science, 4OR, ITOR, TOP.

She has given seminars at several universities and has been invited speaker at several international conferences and international schools for PhD students.

She organized international conferences, such as the first workshop on "Models and algorithms for planning and scheduling problems (MAPSP)" in Como in 1993 and the "International workshop on distribution logistics" in Brescia in 1998 and 2006. She has been member of the Scientific Committee or of the Program Committee of several international conferences.

She was member of the Committee for the "Best Transportation Science and Logistics Society (TSL) Dissertation Prize" of INFORMS in 2002; member and chair of the jury for the "EURO Excellence in Practice Award" in 2007, 2009 and 2010; member of the jury for the "Robert M. Herman Lifetime Achievement Award" for Transportation Science and Logistics Society (TSL) of INFORMS in 2007, 2009 and 2011. She is member of AIRO and INFORMS.
